# Shelby County Sheriff Gross, Chief Dep. Eckles, Deputies Hoss and McDaniel Earn 2023 Sullivan Brothers Awards of Valor

Recipients of the 2023 “Sullivan Brothers’ Award of Valor” are Shelby County Sheriff’s Office Sheriff Neil Gross, Chief Deputy Cody Eckles, Deputy Jake Hoss, Deputy Bill McDaniel.

At approximately 10:30 a.m. on July 12, 2021, the Shelby County Sheriff’s Office responded to a call of a possible suicidal subject at 4116 Madison Street in Elk Horn, Iowa. Dispatch reported that an adult male - Nelson Guyer - had poured gasoline all over the residence and was going to blow himself and the house up. Dispatch also reported that he had screwed the doors shut from the inside.

When Sheriff Neil Gross and Deputy Kelly Lefeber arrived at the house, they could smell gasoline and observed Guyer through a window striking a lighter. Several law enforcement agencies were called to evacuate the area and establish a perimeter around the residence. Negotiators from the Shelby County Sheriff’s Office were called as well.

Over the next two hours, negotiators spoke with Guyer on and off by phone as other officers secured the perimeter and maintained visuals on Guyer. On two different occasions, gunfire was observed from the residence.

At approximately 12:30 p.m., negotiators advised they believed Guyer was going to peacefully surrender and would be exiting the residence through the south door. A reaction team was made up of Chief Deputy Cody Eckles, Deputy Jake Hoss, Deputy Bill McDaniel, and K9 Deputy Pigsley with K9 Odin. A call then came over the radio alerting them that black smoke was coming from the north side of the residence and flames soon became visible from inside

the residence. Negotiators lost contact with Guyer and then observed him pounding on the window in the door on the south side of the residence. Guyer told negotiators he couldn’t get out of the house.

Upon instruction, Deputy Hoss breached a window on the south side to give Guyer a way out. However, the opening wasn’t big enough for Guyer to escape the now heavily burning residence. Guyer continued banging on the glass of the door and yelling for help.

At this point, Guyer had fired a weapon at least twice. It was possible he was planning an ambush or luring officers inside in a final attempt at suicide by cop. In the moment, a decision was made to breach the residence in order to save Guyer, despite the risk to their safety.

While carrying a ballistic shield, Chief Deputy Eckles led Deputy Hoss, Deputy McDaniel, and Sheriff Gross to the south door of the residence. Sheriff Gross breached the door with a battering ram, then he and Deputy McDaniel drug Guyer

out of the residence, which was engulfed in flames. Guyer was brought to medical personnel and transported to a hospital.

It was later confirmed that Guyer had screwed the doors shut and had a loaded AR15-style rifle with him inside the doorway where he was rescued.

If not for the courageous actions by Sheriff Gross, Chief Deputy Eckles, Deputy Hoss, and Deputy McDaniel, Guyer surely would have lost his life inside the burning residence. Guyer had taken several actions that indicated he planned on taking his own life - barricading himself inside the house, firing a gun, pouring accelerant, and finally lighting a fire.

Knowing all this and confronting the very real possibility that Guyer could fire shots at them, Sheriff Gross, Chief Deputy Eckles, Deputy Hoss, and Deputy McDaniel still risked their lives to save Guyer’s. Their heroic actions that day are truly worthy of this commendation.

# Linn Co. Deputy Marty Tope Earns Life Saving Commendation for Saving Arrestee Who Attempted Suicide in Hospital Room

On January 8, Deputy Marty Tope arrested a woman for OWI. She was involved in an accident and after her arrest stated she was injured and needed medical attention. Deputy Tope transported her to a local hospital for examination.

When hospital personnel determined the woman would be released, Deputy Tope stood outside her room as she changed into her clothes. After waiting a reasonable amount of time, Deputy Tope called into the room to see if she was dressed. She advised she was not yet ready, and Deputy Tope again waited briefly before ask-

ing if she was ready to go. When she did not respond, Deputy Tope opened the door and saw the woman sitting on a chair facing the wall. When he walked up to her, Deputy Tope saw she had tied medical monitor cords around her neck, her face was red and it was clear she was not breathing.

Deputy Tope called for assistance as he tried to get the cords untied from around the woman's neck. Being unable to quickly untie the cords, hospital staff directed Deputy Tope to cut and remove the wires from the woman's neck as she was starting to lose

consciousness. She was able to breathe on her own and the medical staff checked her for additional injuries. After monitoring her, the woman was released from the hospital and taken to jail.

If not for Deputy Tope's diligence in checking on the woman and his quick actions after finding the monitor cords wrapped tightly around her neck, it is likely that the woman would have suffered serious, if not life-threatening injuries or possible death. Because of his attentiveness and thoroughness, Deputy Marty Tope was presented a Life Saving Commendation.

It was a big hit at the local National Night Out where we even had a line of cars following us as it was driven back to the Sheriff's Office at the end of the night because the general public wanted better photos of it.

The current radiator needs to be replaced so slow speed driving is a NO GO right now. A new radiator was purchased for it that will make it easier to show off, especially during slow speed parades. It was fairly expensive, but it was at the recommendation of our local mechanic who knows the type of events we want the Model A in. Our mechanic plans to donate his skills and time for the much-needed upgrade for free when his schedule allows.

Our local police fleet vendor/up-fitter did some electrical work on it last summer and helped clean up a few loose wires. The upgrades hid and configured the wiring that goes to the lights and siren and also make it easier for the driver and/or passenger to use them.

**Future Plans/Events:** We were contacted by the Discovery Channel to take part in a series called Hidden America. Plans are in the very beginning stages, but they are already asking about potentially filming in late Spring.

We did a 'live event' on Facebook (Q & A type event) at our RailsWest Museum that was a big hit. Local Historians, members of the public and guest speakers were featured

during our several-hour live event about local histories. It was so well received that it has already been requested that we do an event live from the Squirrel Cage Jail -- from inside the cage -- featuring specific topics including the history of the Squirrel Cage Jail and local Law enforcement.

**ISSDA Trailer Donation:** The Museum was given the old ISSDA trailer to assist in the gathering, receiving, and transporting of museum artifacts. Thanks to a grant from Iowa Tourism and the Travel Iowa campaign the trailer has received a face lift. We plan to use the trailer as much as we can, not only for its actual purpose, but also as a mobile billboard advertising the museum(s).

**Exciting Announcement:** The Pottawattamie County Jail and Sheriff's Residence, popularly known as the "Squirrel Cage Jail," and most recently dignified as the "ISSDA West-Museum," has been listed on the National Register of Historic Places since 1982. Following a decade-long process that distinction has been upgraded. But we recently received an email saying we are now listed with the United States National Park Service as a National Historic Landmark.

We now have federal protection, more (and

easier) access to grants, and the backing of the National Park Service.
